Nominations will be accepted to fill multiple board seats from members rolling off the board in two rounds. The first-round deadline is **December 13, 2024 by end of day**. If all positions are filled in the first round, a second round will not be held. ### ABOUT

The US Green Building Council, Louisiana Chapter (USGBC Louisiana) is an aligned chapter of USGBC and maintains a separate governance structure to better serve the needs of our state.

The Board of Directors is comprised of active volunteer chapter members and consists of the Chair, Vice Chair, Treasurer, Secretary, and committee chairs. Throughout the year, board members work together through committees to provide continuing education courses, networking events, service opportunities, and resources to chapter members and local communities.

### EXPECTATIONS

- Must be a chapter member of USGBC Louisiana
- Each term is a 2 year commitment
- Make time to carry out chapter responsibilities and participate in events (up to 10hrs per month)
- Attend monthly board meetings and monthly committee meetings. All but two meetings will be virtual.
- Chair or co-chair one of the chapter's committees or serve in a elected governance position
- Stay informed about chapter business and inform the board of committee business
- Work with all board members in good faith towards the achievement of USGBC Louisiana's objectives and advancement of the chapter mission
- Participate in fundraising and membership drives
- Ensure legal and ethical integrity
- Excuse themselves from matters that present a conflict of interest and remain transparent and accountable,
- *Optional: If you are able, support the chapter with any combination of personal donations or third-party sponsorships annually with a suggested value of \$200 over the course of the year in addition to annual Louisiana chapter membership dues.*

Attendance at Board meetings and Chapter activities is essential and required. Board meetings are held monthly via a virtual meeting platform except for two in-person planning meetings. Board members should expect to chair or co-chair a committee. Committees are supported by general members and former board members.

Joining the board will present opportunities to be a leader on the forefront of sustainability in Louisiana and to network with industry leaders implementing green design and policies. Young professionals gain leadership skills employers value and seasoned professionals share their knowledge with others to guide the chapter to its mission.
